City Directories of Redlands, California

Ann Cordy Deegan, Author and Speaker Monday, September 22, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. Assembly Room, A.K. Smiley Public Library 125 W. Vine Street

Ann Cordy Deegan will discuss her latest publication "Redlands City Directories 1896-1967" when the Redlands Area Historical Society meets in September. The publication is a San Bernardino County Museum Association Quarterly for 2014. The directories include information on Bryn Mawr, Calimesa, Crafton, Loma Linda, Mentone, Oak Glen, Redlands and Yucaipa. The spiral bound book is available at the County Museum.

Deegan co-authored "Images of America: Early Redlands" last year with new Smiley Library archivist, Maria Carrillo, which featured profiles on some thirty photographers of early Redlands. This book is available at Smiley Library.

Deegan received her Ph.D. from the University of Maryland and her M.S. and B.S. degrees from University of California, Davis. She has been working in history museums and archives and (Continued on page 3)

He sold it to A. N. Dike, whose family members lived in the house for many decades. It was among the first homes to receive a historic award, back in 1976.

The Sibilles will tell us of the changes that have occurred in the appearance and structure of the house. In the several years that they have lived there, the modifications that they have made have all been ones of necessity, or of a desire to re-instate the original feel of the house. They have enjoyed filling the house with antiques.
